TC ROBERTSON NATURE RESERVE

Postance: 2.2km | C: 074 792 0605
You will find TC Robertson nature Reserve off the Old Main South Coast Road just north of the Mpambinyoni River bridge. This beautiful reserve is a green lung of the town, a favoured picnic spot with 180 species of bird, blue and grey duiker and a coastal trail popular with those keen on coastal trees. It has 12km of established self-guided trails that wend their way through forest, coastal grasslands, wetlands, river and estuary systems.

SHARK CAGE DIVING

Distance: 7.2km | T: 039 973 2233
This is truly an exciting once in a lifetime experience. Bond with family, friends or colleagues as you get close up to the many species of shark found at Aliwal Shoal.
Shark cage diving involves diving in heavy metal cages in the warm waters of Durban's Aliwal Shoal. Shark species that can be found are Blacktip sharks, Dusky Sharks, Spinner Sharks, Tiger and Zambezi Sharks.

CROCWORLD

Distance: 4.1km | T: 039 976 1103 This amazing paradise is spread out over 24ha and laid out in a park-like setting with walkways meandering through it. The indigenous gardens were developed as a showcase and to inspire visitors on how to garden successfully with indigenous plants at home. There are plenty of shady trees and benches if you want to sit down and take in the scenery. This wheelchair-friendly venue is ideal for a family outing and will entertain everyone with a variety of things to do and see. Since the conservation is the main focus of this park, most of the animals and birds you will see here were either born in captivity or injured and are unable to take care of themselves in the wild.

MOKARRAN DIVE CHARTERS

Distance: 7.2km | C: 084 496 0057
Dive into adventure with the dream team at Mokarran Dive Charters! Conveniently located inside Rocky Bay Resorts.
Surrounded by indigenous forest with private beach access along a wooden walkway. It's a short stroll to the beach and boat launch area. Diving takes place in the world renowned Aliwal Shoal MPA (Marine Protected Area) rated by the legendary Jacques Cousteau as one of the Top 10 Dive Sites worldwide.

SCOTTBURGH GOLF COURSE

Distance: 1.5km | C: 087 150 1312
This undulating golf course has the most attractive setting with views and sounds of the Indian Ocean. Comparatively short at 5323m it boasts two par 5's and five spectacular par 3 holes, with the par 4 third hole being the most talked about hole on the course. Like all coastal golf courses, Scottburgh can become quite tricky in the wind but one of the most spectacular shots is from the par 4 18th hole, where one flies the drive over towering trees, into the wild blue to hopefully drop onto the fairway below.

HORSES AND HEALING

A great destination and experience for family outings, team building workshops and a couples' outing. All horses have adjusted well to their new surroundings and they are sure to make for an exceptional ride with beautiful sea views and lovely trails guided by experienced riders.

GO BANANAZ

Distance: 29.6km | C: 084 565 2116
Located in the beautiful town of Amanzimtoti.
Go Bananaz is an epic children's adventure park and party venue that caters to the inbetweeners for children U/11 years offering good clean & safe outdoor fun. They have a super tube, water slide and air gym, as well as a Ferris wheel and foody swing. The friendly staff make this place great. They also have a tuck shop which serves snacks such as toasted sandwiches, hot dogs, chips, drinks and ice-creams. You can also bring your own food or order platters through them. They do have a few braai stands too, but make sure to book these in advance.

USHAKA MARINE WORLD

Distance: 60.1km | T: 031 328 8000
A world class entertainment theme park and tourism destination located on Durban's Golden Mile. Looking for things to do in Durban, South Africa? uShaka Marine World is a 16ha theme park that opened on 30 April 2004. It has a total capacity of 4.6mil gallons containing 10 000 animal species. Situated just north of KwaZulu-Natal.

AMANZIMTOTI BIRD SANCTUARY

Distance: 32.7km | T: 031 903 1203
The Amanzimtoti Bird Sanctuary is a popular attraction. It consists of a large expanse of open shimmering water surrounded by rolling lawns. Gardens are on the one end and indigenous lush forests on the other. An effortless 30min self-guided trail winds itself through the forest and is a haven for birdlife. One has an opportunity of sighting many of the 150 bird species in the sanctuary including the resident Spurwing Geese, White Faced Duck, Greenback Heron, Giant Kingfisher and Hamerkop.
