A Bird's-Eye View

DAY 1 ARRIVAL AT NOGATSAA PANS

Meet your expert birding hosts and guides for an introduction to the experience. Depending on arrival times, enjoy your first guided birding drive before returning to the lodge for dinner.

DAY 2 CHOBE RIVERFRONT DISCOVERY

Set out early from the lodge for a full-day birding adventure to the Chobe Riverfront. Explore floodplains, riverbanks and wetlands, discovering species by call, movement, habitat and markings. Enjoy a 2hr river cruise, ideal for spotting summer waterbirds, raptors and migratory species. Return with exceptional sightings shaped by the season's abundant waters.

DAY 3 BIRDS OF NOGATSAA PANS

Enjoy morning and afternoon birding activities, with time to focus on photography, bird calls, behaviour and the finer details often missed on a traditional safari. Explore the pans, woodlands and plains during peak bird activity, learning to

identify species by call, movement, habitat and markings. Look out for remarkable sightings shaped by the summer rains.

DAY 4 TRANSFER TO GHOHA HILLS

After a final morning birding activity and breakfast, depart Nogatsaa for Ghoha Hills. Observe changing habitats and add new species to your list along the way. On arrival at Ghoha Hills and settle in before an afternoon birding activity or leisure time before dinner.

DAY 5 SAVUTI MARSH EXPERIENCE

Half-day game drive to the Savuti Marsh exploring grasslands, woodlands and seasonal waterways and search for resident and migratory bird species and Chobe's larger wildlife.

DAY 6 FINAL DAY

Enjoy one last morning birding experience followed by breakfast. Depart Ghoha Hills for your road transfer back to Kasane.

A Chobe River boat cruise will be included within the programme, determined by arrival and departure times. From the water, look out for kingfishers, herons, storks, African fish eagles and other species associated with the river and floodplains.
